NTXRCIC Technology Start-up Pitch Day

On Thursday November 17, 2011, the NTXRCIC will host a pitch day for start-up ventures in the technology field. The NTXRCIC's mission is to promote entrepreneurship and investment in quality technology based start-ups. Pitch day is an opportunity for entrepreneurs with a start-up venture of less than five years, a protected technology and a solid team, to pitch to the NTXRCIC family of investors.

Investors have been selected from private family wealth, angel groups, serial investors and Venture Capitalist firms, to listen to pre-screened deals that are seeking \$100,000 - \$3,000,000 in equity investment. To be sure to secure your spot, apply today.

How Do I Apply To Pitch?

To start the process, all companies must submit a plan through our website www.ntxrcic.org. The application due date is **September 27, 2011**. Once we receive your submission, your company will be invited to visit with the NTXRCIC to review the technology and business plan with one of our team members. No company will be permitted to pitch that has not gone through the NTXRCIC screening process.

If selected to proceed forward in our process, companies will be coached, mentored and counseled on pitching their business to regional experts and investors in the technology markets.

Pitch Day Schedule:

Entrepreneurs and investors will be invited to the pitch day from 1:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. The first pitch will commence promptly at 1:40 p.m. Each pitch will be a 15 minute pitch followed by 5 minutes of Q&A. Selected companies will pitch to pre-screened, qualified investors only. A two page investor summary will be available to the audience.
